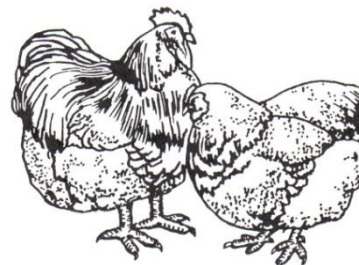

This trophy will remain in possession of the winner until the following year's county fair at which time it shall be returned and presented to the current year's winner.

Young pen: One cockerel and two pullets hatched after January 1st of the current year.
Old pen: One cock and two hens hatched prior to January 1st of the current year.
Cock: Male bird hatched prior to January 1st of the current year.
Hen: Female bird hatched prior to January 1st of the current year.
Cockerel: Male bird hatched after January 1st of the current year.
Pullet: Female bird hatched after January 1st of the current year.
AOV: Any other variety.
