1. All Department A rules apply to this division.
2. Pay Stall Fee only once if entering animal in both Open and Junior Shows.
3. **Exhibitors must be ages 21 and under to enter.**
4. All exhibitors must be present to show their own animals.
5. **FANS – No butt fans allowed. Overhead fans may be used. Fans must be securely mounted above the animal with a limit of one fan for each three animals. No fans will be permitted to be in the aisle, on a cart, or on the floor of the barn.** More fans permitted with use of personal generator. All extension cords for fans must be outdoor approved – heavy gauge.
6. Electrical power is limited: the use of generators is strongly encouraged – generators are NOT permitted in the barn. Please indicate on your entry form if you plan to use a generator.
7. All Simmental must be 50% or greater as shown on the required registration papers.
8. ENTER ALL MARKET STEERS IN THE LIGHT WEIGHT LOT OF THEIR CLASS.
9. **Hobby / Specialty class intended for American Aberdeen, Lowline Angus, Miniature Hereford, Dexter, Highland, Belted Galloway breeds. Class is non-competitive.**
10. See rules and regulations of the Bureau County Agricultural Board, State of Illinois and Livestock Open and Junior Livestock Show rules.
11. **Bureau County Angus Assn** will be sponsoring separate classes during the Jr. Heifer and Steer Show. See section on Bureau County Angus Assn Show.
