- 1. All articles must be hand crafted by the exhibitor, with the exception of the antique/heritage articles.
- 2. All quilts and other items for hanging require a sleeve on the back. Quilts entered without a sleeve will have a sleeve attached by a fair volunteer and will not be eligible for judging, premiums, or Best in Show.
- 3. All items to be made by exhibitor except for Heritage Needlework- Class 7.
- 4. Stained or discolored articles will be disqualified, other than heritage/antique articles.
- 5. All articles should be made within the last two years except for heritage/antique articles.
- 6. As of the 2019 fair, 3 new classifications have been added:

MD-1-15220 – Quit of Valor (55"x65" minimum size, 72"x90" maximum size) patriotic colored theme fabric and pattern must be used. Quilt must be pieced, quilted and bound by exhibitor, machine or hand quilted by a professional quilter.

MD-1-15221 – Quit of Valor (55"x65" minimum size, 72"x90" maximum size) patriotic colored theme fabric and pattern must be used. Quilt must be pieced, quilted and bound by exhibitor.

MD-1-15222 – Quit Bee, quilts made by two or more people (i.e. exhibitor pieced top and quilted by another person; quilts made from a block exchange; quilts made by a group) machine or hand quilted.

- * Quilts of Valor (QOV) will be taken down and awarded as a ceremony during the Bureau County Fair. When the QOV is entered, the exhibitor will declare who they would like the quilt to be awarded to at the ceremony. The exhibitor is responsible for notifying the awardee and having them present for the ceremony at the fair. If the exhibitor does not have a veteran in mind, the exhibitor may donate the quilt to QOV to be awarded to a veteran at the ceremony or at a later date. All QOV will be required to have a label stating it is a QOV, who made it (i.e. Susie S., no last names), and who quilted it. If the recipient is unknown, leave a blank space for adding the future recipient's name and date awarded.
- 7. The following score card will serve as a general guide to exhibitors of needlework in preparing their exhibits and will be followed by the judge in making awards.
- 8. See rules and regulations of the Bureau County Agricultural Board and Fine Arts
- 9. "Any Other Not Listed" classes must be items where there is <u>no</u> category listed elsewhere. (i.e. a skirt can only be exhibited in the skirt class)
