

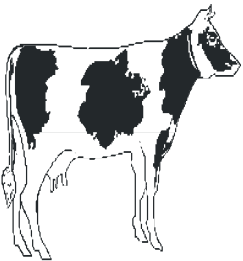

1. All animals over 4 month of age must be registered.
2. Registration papers are required for all purebred livestock. A copy of registration papers must be presented at office before exhibiting.
3. All animals over 3 years of age must give satisfactory evidence to the judge of being breeders or be expelled from competition. **SUPERINTENDENTS WILL STRICTLY ENFORCE THIS RULE.**
4. No cow will be permitted to show in more than one cow class.
5. Only first place winners will be eligible to show in the champion class.
6. Where stalls are not permanent, tie space for each animal will be approximately 3 feet.
7. Milking cows will be allowed to go home after their show.
8. See rules and regulations of the Bureau County Agricultural Board, State of Illinois and Livestock Open Class.



Definitions of group classes

- Best 3 Female:** Bred and owned by exhibitor.
- Junior Heifer Calf:** March 1, 2026 to June 1, 2026
- Intermediate Heifer Calf:** December 1, 2025 to February 28, 2026
- Senior Heifer Calf:** September 1, 2025 to November 30, 2025
- Summer Yearling Heifer:** June 1, 2025 to August 31, 2025
- Junior Yearling Heifer:** March 1, 2025 to May 31, 2025
- Intermediate Yearling Heifer:** December 1, 2024 to February 28, 2025
- Senior Yearling Heifer:** September 1, 2024 to November 30, 2025
